Strathalbyn

Historic Strathalbyn's first hospital was established in 1905 as a small cottage hospital, to meet the needs of a growing rural town and district community. From these humble beginnings nearly 100 years ago, a modern health service comprising over 90 beds has evolved. The Health Service incorporates a public hospital, residential aged care and a day centre, to meet the increased needs of a growing community. Medical services provided by the 28 bed hospital include acute medical, surgical, fast-stream rehabilitation, gerontic and palliative care. In addition, a 24 hour accident and emergency service is available with medical support provided by general practitioners from Strathalbyn Clinic and assisted by ambulance support from the SA Ambulance Service (Strathalbyn Branch). The operating theatre is in use up to 4 times per fortnight.

Mount Barker & District Health Services

Mount Barker is situated in the Adelaide Hills and is a 30 Minute drive from the CBD in Adelaide. The town's population is over 8,000 and is a fast growing area in South Australia. The hospital has 34 beds of which 6 are Maternity, 9 Surgical and 19 Medical. Services include a 24 hours accident and emergency department, 2 Operating Theatres which operate every day, a Day Surgery department which operates every day and the Maternity Unit with 300 deliveries annually.

Gumeracha and District Soldiers Memorial Hospital

Gumeracha is a township set in the beautiful Torrens Valley region of the northern Adelaide Hills, 36 km north-east of Adelaide City in South Australia.

Set in the rolling hills, the town is surrounded by vineyards, olive groves, orchards and farmland. The population of 700 is a mixture of long-standing residents connected to farming, horticulture or viticulture, and commuters working in the metropolitan area.

People of the town are proud of the town's heritage, community spirit and friendly welcoming atmosphere. The Gumeracha District Soldiers' Memorial Hospital is a thirty (30) bed public hospital serving Gumeracha and its surrounding areas. The Hospital provides services predominantly in acute medical, aged care, and primary health care.

The Hospital also provides a twenty-four (24) hour accident and emergency department for the Community. There is access to private Radiology Monday to Friday.

Mount Pleasant District Hospital

Mount Pleasant with a population of approximately 900 people, is ideally located less than an hour from Adelaide, 20 mins from the River Murray, and right at the junction of the Barossa Valley and the Adelaide Hills.

The Mount Pleasant District Hospital provides medical, aged care, surgical - including an Operating Theatre, and Accident & Emergency services. We have 34 beds plus a close observation ("HDU") area and a recently refurbished Palliative Care Suite.

South Coast & District Health Service Inc.

The township of Victor Harbor has long been a favoured holiday destination.

Situated 80km south of Adelaide with a southern ocean frontage, the township offers an enjoyable experience for everyone. Population is approximately Victor Harbor – Goolwa area approx 20,000 which increases at least 3 fold over summer.

SCDH: has 26 beds and 2 chairs, all general medical services are provided for in the health service. The 2 chairs: Blood Transfusions, some chemotherapy, iron infusions and intragam infusions. Soon to start haemodialysis and Surgery 7-8 lists per week, Orthopaedics, urology, general surgery, ENT, Ophthalmology, Gastroenterology procedures. 24 hour A&E department – approx 50 retrievals per year. Mid – approx 130 births per year using Midwives group practice Victor Harbor Private Hospital (co located) has 18 beds

Kangaroo Island Health Service

Located in Kingscote with a population of 1,500 but is the only health service on the island. Total catchment area is 4,500 residents and approximately 160,000 visitors per annum. The hospital is 45 beds which are : 15 Acute, 20 high level aged care and 10 low level aged care. 1 operating theatre which is used approximately once per week. There is the island midwifery team. In 2008 there was 68 births. There is a large comprehensive community health service which operates across the whole island.

Mallee Coorong Cluster

Mallee Health Service Incorporated

Mallee Health Service Incorporated began operation on 1 July 2002. The implementation of the Mallee Health Service followed two years of planning and community consultation in the district.

Karoonda & District Soldiers' Memorial Hospital, Karoonda Homes for the Aged, Lameroo District Health Service, Lameroo Homes for the Aged and Pinnaroo Soldiers' Memorial Hospital amalgamated to form the Mallee Health Service. Other new programs implemented include: Mental Health Services; Youth Programs; Cancer Support; Specialist Nursing positions (wound care, continence, gender health, diabetes, immunization and cardiac care). Primary Care programs including additional services in physiotherapy, podiatry, occupational therapy and dietetics have been introduced.

Transport services for the region have also improved in partnership with the local councils and the Passenger Transport Board.

Murray Bridge Health Service

The Murray Bridge Soldiers Memorial Hospital was established in 1923. The hospital has undergone several redevelopments and growth in that time. Presently the hospital is a 47 bed acute hospital comprising of medical, surgical, maternity, accident/emergency, dialysis and an operating theatre complex which includes day surgery. Supporting services include a laboratory service, medical imaging including ultra sound and CT scanner, infection control, mental health and a close partnership with the Community Health service.

Mannum Hospital

Mannum District Hospital over looks the River Murray, and supports a population of approximately 3,000 along with a large transient population, especially during the summer months. The Hospital has 24 beds, of which 15 are allocated to Residential Aged Care services. There is a 24 x 7 Accident and Emergency facility, and 9 beds for acute/chronic illness. In addition the Hospital supports a Domiciliary Care service which serves a wide area within the Mid Murray Council. There is also a Day Centre within the Hospital which supports Community groups, Aged persons and those with disabilities. Mannum Medical Centre is collocated with the Hospital and there is a range of Primary Health Care services provided through the Hospital and Medical Centre.

Coorong Health Service, Multi Purpose Service

Meningie & Districts Memorial Hospital & Health Services Campus:

Meningie is situated 150 kms from Adelaide on the shore of Lake Albert and at the beginning of The Coorong. The catchment area spans several towns from Salt Creek in the South East, along the Dukes Highway (Coonalpyn & Tintinara) and out to Narung and Raukkan. The Health Service has recently become a Multi Purpose Service in partnership with Tailem Bend Health Service. The Meningie Campus is a twenty- four (24) bed service which provides acute, aged and 24/7 emergency department access to the town and surrounding districts. The service also has a Community Health arm which supports clinical and social services at Coonalpyn, Tintinara, Meningie and Raukkan.

There is significant opportunity to enhance not only acute, aged care and A&E skills but to also work in the area of Primary Health Care across a culturally diverse population. There is also the added bonus of being able to work between two (2) Health Services i.e. Tailem Bend (which is ½ hour drive away) & Meningie. There is a co located Medical Practice which is privately managed and works in partnership with the health service to provide many services to the community.

The future looks bright for the Coorong Health Service as we plan to enhance & expand a number of our Primary Health Services in partnership with the Tailem Bend Campus.

Tailem Bend District Hospital

The Tailem Bend township and hospital are situated 100km from Adelaide on the South Eastern Freeway. The hospital is situated on the banks overlooking the meandering River Murray

The Tailem Bend Campus is a twenty five (25) bed facility serving the Tailem Bend township and its surrounding areas. The hospital provides acute care, residential aged care and a 24 hour accident and emergency department. The facility also has a Community Health service with a Primary health and Community Leisure and Activities interest to support people in the town and surrounding area with clinical visits and social opportunities. Tailem Bend is a growing town and together with Meningie Hospital Campus look forward to offering opportunities and expanding services to support our staff and the communities
