

COUNTRY HEALTH SA BAROSSA AND YORKE PENINSULA CLUSTERS TRANSITION TO PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE PROGRAM 2011

Country Health SA Barossa, Gawler Eudunda and Kapunda Cluster with the Yorke and Lower North Health Cluster is the second most populous country health region, with an estimated resident population of 95,000 people (ABS, 1998). Geographically, this is a large and diverse area including the areas of Yorke Peninsula, Lower North, Gawler, Barossa and Light. The region is recognised nationally and internationally as a tourist destination and there is a diverse range of primary industries. The Barossa Valley is well known for its wines, the Yorke Peninsula for barley and wheat, magnificent beaches and fishing and the Lower North for wine (in particular the Clare Valley), wool and cereal growing. The clusters have a comprehensive range of public, private and community based health services. Country Health SA is responsible for ensuring the provision of public health services to the resident and visiting populations.

The service providers in the two clusters are comprised of hospitals, aged care facilities and community health services.

Barossa, Gawler, Kapunda and Eudunda Cluster

Gawler Health Service-a 56 bed hospital and Community Health Service including medical, surgical(including day surgery) and midwifery services. The midwifery unit has 400 deliveries per year.

Barossa Health has two sites - Angaston Hospital- a 26 bed acute hospital features Acute medical & specialist surgical services, including a 24 hour AnE service. The Community Health Service is located at this site.

Tanunda hospital – is a 23 bed acute hospital features acute medical & specialist surgical services, including a 24 hour AnE service. Maternity services with 160 deliveries per year.

Kapunda Hospital – 23 acute beds, acute medical surgical, AnE with a maternity service of 70 deliveries per year. Attached is a 26 bed residential facility.

Eudunda Hospital – a 16 bed aged care facility with 6 acute beds, 24 emergency service, general medical and palliative care services.
